

Program Overview

VT in Spain is a featured study abroad program at Virginia Tech and has been returning to Spain yearly since 1975. It is designed to help students develop the language skills and cultural experiences vital to international competence through participation in a carefully structured program of total immersion in the language and culture of Spain.

Students **live with Spanish families**, not other Americans, in order to maximize their opportunity to immerse and learn more about the culture!

The program is based in **Madrid**, Spain's bustling capital filled with superior shopping as well as **cultural and historic attractions**. The basic structure of the program includes class 4 days a week (Monday-Thursday) with weekend excursions to famous cities around Spain to give students a grasp of the rich cultural diversity in this amazing country.

Course Credit

Projected Costs

The projected cost for living in Spain and touring 11 cities in 2017 is \$5,895 plus airfare (typically around \$1400) and VT tuition (projected around \$2575 for instate). The basic \$5,895 fee includes a non-refundable deposit of \$1,000 due upon acceptance into the program; international ID card; transportation to and from the airport in Madrid; full room and board in Madrid; texts and materials used in courses: cultural visits: transportation, hotel, and breakfast for group trips around Spain; health insurance; and transcripts. NOT included in this amount are: Virginia Tech reduced study-abroad tuition; airfare to and from Spain; subway passes in Spain; 15 meals during travel to other cities; and personal expenses. Scholarships are available.
